REPOSITIONING

The AIA National Board met last week and made some very important decisions which will impact how the Institute is governed. They adopted a new governance structure that will position the AIA to more effectively address important issues affecting members and the profession. They will move to a bicameral board: a smaller Board of Directors comprised of 11 to 15 members which will have well-defined strategic and fiduciary responsibility, and a second larger Council which will develop vision for the compelling issues of the day that impact the profession. The goal is to have a Board that more efficiently and effectively focuses on operational issues and allow the Council to fully engage with strategic issues concerning practice, the profession and society.
