

As architects, we solve problems, but we recognize not all organizations can budget for our services. The Weight of Architecture Design Service Grant was intended to provide design assistance to local 501(c) 3 non-profit organizations that could benefit from the services of skilled architects and designers and that would not otherwise have the resources to retain such services. Over the past year, teams met with the selected nonprofits to assess and analyze a challenge identified by their The outcome of the service grant was an implementable design solution to the selected nonprofits, but the program was also crafted to instill leadership talent in a young group of architects, giving them the opportunity to make new connections and gain valuable experience in finding projects and delivering solutions as design professionals. The project was intended to establish a dialogue with and build connections between the nonprofit community and the local architectural profession in Columbus. The Weight of Architecture Project provided a valuable opportunity to connect the altruistic purposes of nonprofits with the potential of architects to affect real change in the built environment – all to the benefit of our communities.
