Diane Jacobs, FAIA – Jury Chair

Diane Jacobs, FAIA is the founder of Holly Street Studio, a design firm located in Downtown Phoenix, AZ. In 1999, she left behind a successful trajectory in corporate architecture to start what was to be a ‘temporary endeavor’ in the front room of their bungalow on Holly Street. She used this opportunity to challenge both the thinking and delivery of architecture along with her partner Michael Jacobs, AIA, who joined the firm in 2002. With an outstanding staff of creative and critical thinkers, they have grown the firm’s portfolio to include dozens of sustainable, award-winning projects in the public realm at all scales – for universities, community colleges, municipalities, non-profit foundations, and local small businesses. Diane is a lifelong champion of community causes, including National AIA Women’s Leadership Summit, AIA AZ Women’s Leadership Group, National Organization of Minority Architects, Urban Land Institute, and Local First Arizona. She holds a position as Faculty Associate at ASU’s Design School, and is a member of the University of Arizona CAPLA Futures Council. Diane received the AIA Arizona Architect’s Medal in 2016, and led Holly Street Studio to AIA AZ Firm of the Year in 2017.



Jared Della Valle, FAIA

Jared Della Valle has been a real estate professional and architect for more than 20 years and has managed the acquisition and predevelopment of more than 2 million sf in New York City along the Highline, in the Hudson Yards, in DUMBO and in Downtown Brooklyn. Jared Della Valle is Vice Chair of the Van Alen Institute, sits on the Board of the the Architecture League of New York, and the Downtown Brooklyn Partnership and is a member of the U.S. Green Building Council. He has previously taught at Columbia University, Syracuse University, Washington University, Parsons School of Constructed Environments and Lehigh University. Jared has widely lectured at major universities and institutions and his work has been the subject of more than 50 articles and publications including a monograph entitled “Think/Make” published by Princeton Architecture Press. He holds a B.A. from Lehigh University and Master’s degrees in both Architecture and Construction Management from Washington University, St. Louis, MO. He is a LEED Certified, licensed Architect in New York State, holds an NCARB (National College of Architectural Registration Boards) Certificate and is a licensed real estate broker and a Fellow of the AIA (American Institute of Architects).



Natasha Espada, AIA, NOMA

Natasha Espada, AIA, NOMA, LEED AP BD+C, is the founder and Principal of STUDIO ENÉE architects. She has 30 years of design and construction expertise in both renovation and new construction for institutional, civic, cultural, and commercial clients. Natasha was the 2020 President of the Boston Society of Architects (BSA)/AIA and co-chair of the Equity, Diversity, Inclusion and Social Justice Task Force. Natasha is an active member of the BSA’s Women’s Principal’s group, a presenter at the AIA Women’s Leadership Summit, the curator of the Women In Design exhibit: Urban Interventions: Women Designing in Boston, and part of the 2022 AIA Puerto Rico Women in Architecture Exhibit. Natasha has been an Adjunct Professor at Northeastern University and a design critic/lecturer at Harvard GSD, MIT, Yale, Wentworth, MassArt, Roger Williams, Auburn, and the BAC. Natasha is the Vice Chair of the Town of Needham’s Planning Board, Climate Action Plan Committee, Co-Chair of Needham’s Affordable Housing Planning Committee, and Board Member for Needham United Against Racism. Natasha is a graduate of the University of Florida, holds a Master’s degree in architecture from the University of Virginia with a certificate in American Urbanism, and, in 2021, was awarded an honorary doctorate from Wentworth Institute of Technology.

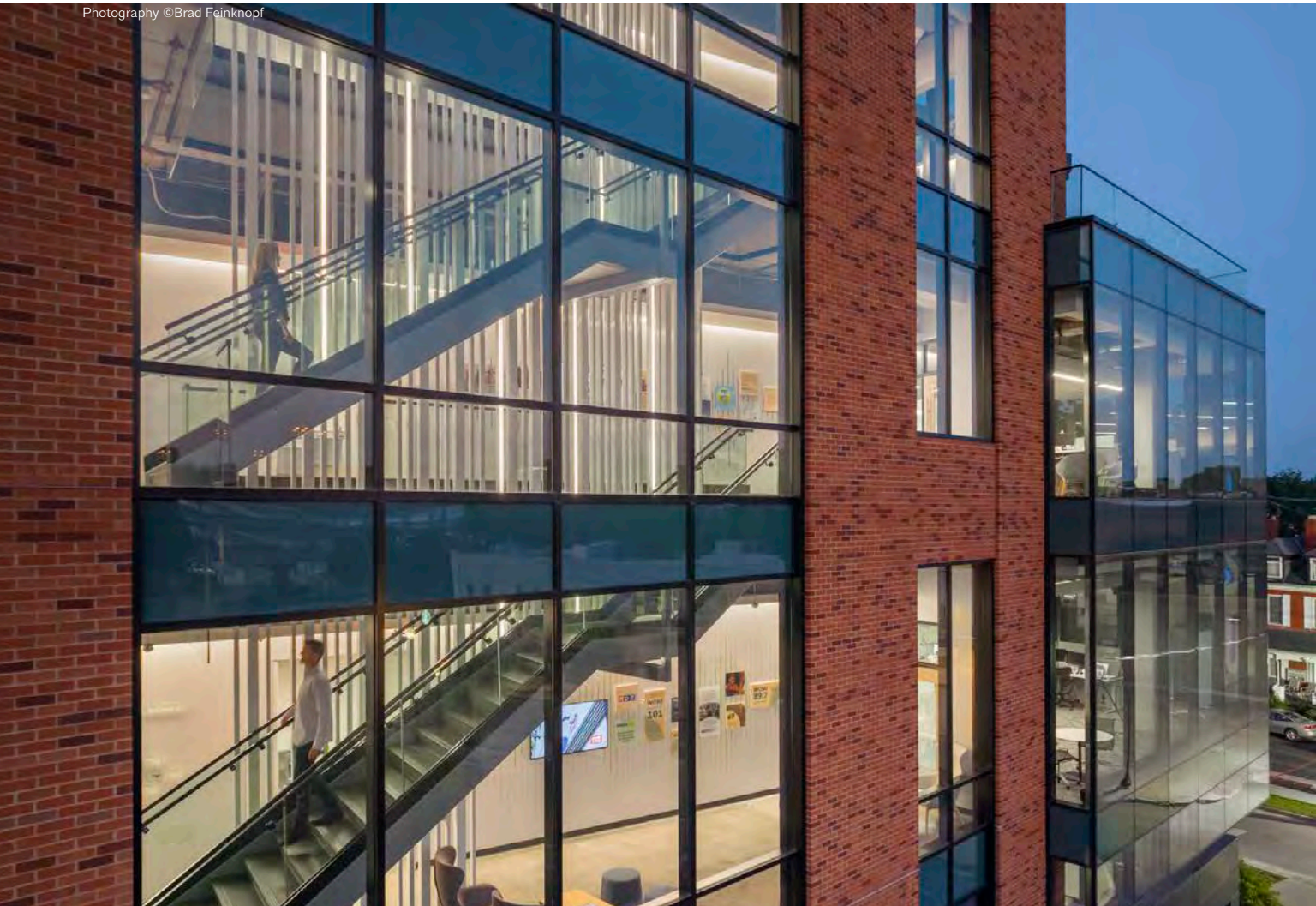


Factory #6 Stair Detail

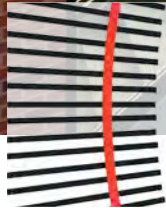

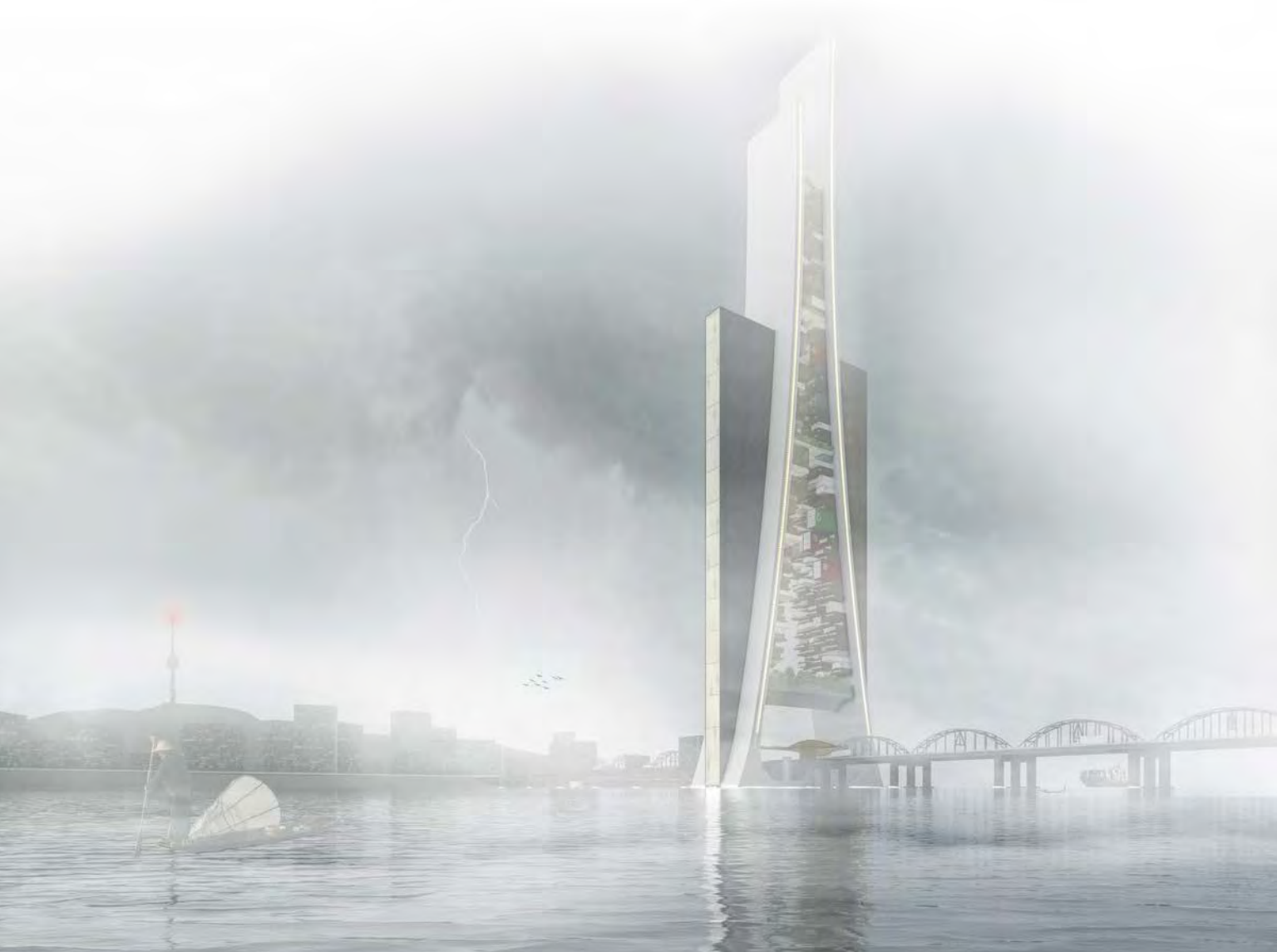

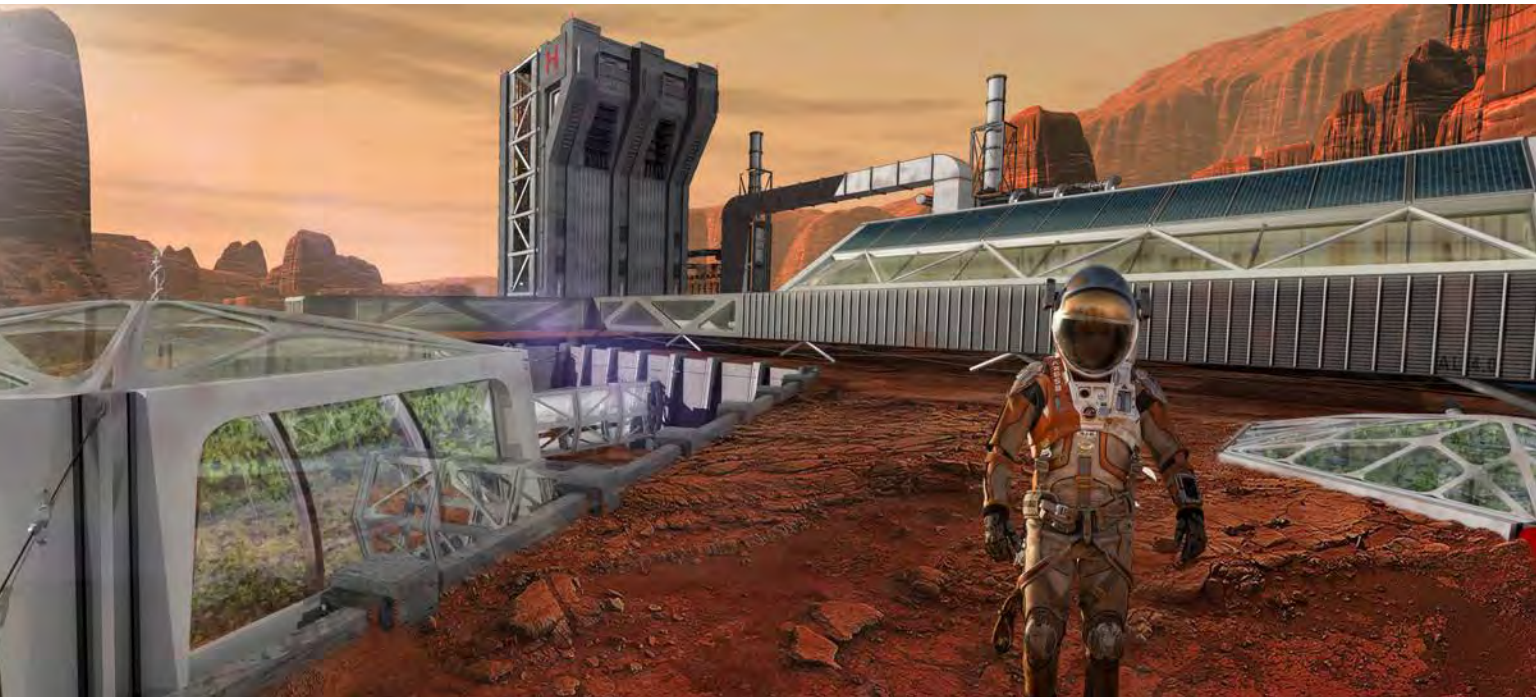


Carbon City: An Urban Machine

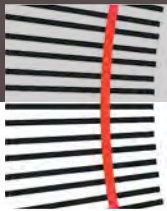
